California Cash for College workshops help California students and their parents apply for financial aid. Each year financial aid professionals volunteer to help students complete the universally required Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) form and the Cal Grant GPA verification form — line-by-line, step-by-step. Both the student and a parent need a PIN to sign the FAFSA. To complete your FAFSA at the workshop, both the student and parent can apply for a PIN at www.pin.ed.gov.

MAKE SURE YOU BRING THIS INFORMATION WITH YOU

- Your PIN and your parent's PIN
- Your Social Security Card and Drivers License or State ID
- Your 2011 Federal Income Tax Return and W2's
- Your parent(s) 2011 Federal Income Tax Return and W2's
- If you haven't filed 2011 taxes yet, 2010 1040's for Parent & Student
- Any record of untaxed income such as temporary disability benefits, child support received, and military or clergy benefits.
- Your alien registration number (if you are not a US citizen).
