## Message from the Principal:

### Parking Lot Information:

*For the last two years, the North Parking Lot has been an area where some students go during lunch. This year, there are three specific challenges we have been facing by this area being used by students:*

- *Supervision: the staff cannot provide direct supervision of students when we cannot see them because they are sitting in their cars during lunch and at break.*
- *Litter: regardless of the number of trash cans, students are leaving litter on the ground in the area around the parking lot. This creates a hardship for our custodial staff.*
- *Safety around cars: because there are pedestrians everywhere in the parking lot during lunch, moving cars creates unsafe traffic situations.*

*Student advisors, administrators and staff have been asking students to help us make this area more manageable, but these three problems continue, so we will be closing the parking lot to students during lunch and break. The official closure date will be announced soon.*

*How can you help? We want to hear your voice! What does our campus need to improve the area at lunch and at breaks? Do we need more seating? A sound system to provide some music during your break? Lawn games? A shade structure? Speak up and let us know what would make your quad more comfortable! You can share your ideas by talking with administration, your core senator, or your ASB so we ensure that your voice gets heard!*

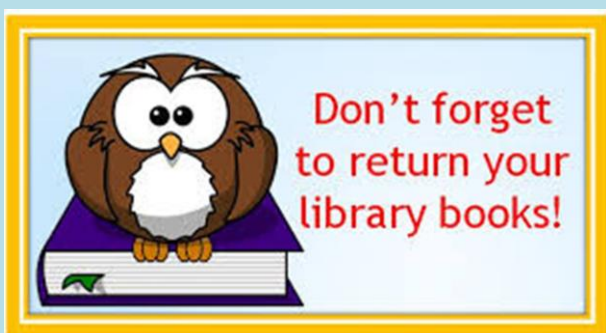
