AVID is designed to increase school-wide learning and performance. The mission of AVID is to ensure that all students, and most especially students in the **middle with academic potential capable of completing a college preparatory path:**

- \*will succeed in rigorous curriculum
- \*will enter mainstream activities of the school
- \*will increase their enrollment in four-year colleges
- \*will become educated and responsible participants and leaders in a democratic society

**Statistics about California AVID Graduates**

- ❖ 95% are enrolled in a college or university
- ❖ 71% are attending a four-year university
- ❖ 24% are attending a two-year college
- ❖ 75% of the graduates are working either full or part-time to send themselves through college
