Scholarship Information from the California Scholarship Federation:

Attention CSF students! It is time again to reapply for CSF. Please see Mrs. Cordell in D109 to get your application. Turn in applications, a copy of your grades and \$5 by Friday, February 9th. Seniors, remember that you must qualify at least 1 of the semesters in your senior year.

Sophomores, this is your first year to qualify for CSF. If you have mostly A's and B's, stop by D109 to see if you qualify!

PSAT Information: Students that took the PSAT in October can pick up their test booklets from Ms. Taddei in the College and Career Center. Student score reports are available online at College Board. To create an account with College Board, visit: <https://cbaccount.collegeboard>.

Seniors still have time to complete the FAFSA or the California Dream Act Application for financial aid to help pay for college expenses. To be eligible for a Cal Grant, seniors must file their applications by March 2.
